



Bob Bolen Leadership Scholarship

The Bob Bolen Leadership Scholarship, provided by the generosity of The Sarah & Ross Perot, Jr. Foundation, honors Robert (Bob) Bolen, former Mayor of Fort Worth. Bob served as Mayor from 1982-1991, and joined the TCU staff as Senior Advisor to the Chancellor in 1991. Bob also serves as a Visiting Lecturer and Advisor to the Dean of the M.J. Neeley School of Business.

The Bob Bolen Leadership Scholarship is open to current college sophomores or juniors who will be juniors or seniors beginning fall 2012. Applicants should exhibit leadership ability and/or potential and a commitment to community service. Current and former military personnel, dependants of current and former military personnel, Eagle Scouts and Gold Scouts are particularly encouraged to apply. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above and documented financial need as determined through the Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid. FAFSA must be received in the Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid by May 1.

- A personal resume that includes:
 - Academic history
 - Work history
 - Extracurricular activities in which you have held leadership roles
 - Community service activities
 - Honors and awards received
 - Your plans after graduation from TCU
- A copy of your academic transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable).
- An essay, no more than 1 page in length, describing the 1 or 2 the most important values you demonstrate as a leader.

Applications and supporting documentation should be submitted to the TCU Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid by May 1.
