## TANDY GRANT PROGRAM

Charles Tandy established a trust fund for the purpose of underwriting grants for employees of the Tandy Corporation and their lineal descendants (i.e. children, grandchildren). The success of the company and the growth in value of its stock have created an important opportunity for assisting Tandy employees and their descendants. The dollar amount of Tandy Grants varies from year to year, depending upon the number of applicants, the amount available from the fund and the financial eligibility of the applicants as determined through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

### REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1) Undergraduate students may declare any major. Graduate students must major in business, engineering or computer science.
- 2) Descendants of Tandy employees must be full-time students (12 or more hours per semester for undergraduates and nine or more for graduate students).
- 3) Tandy employees may be part-time students as long as they continue to be associated with the Tandy Corporation in some manner (part-time employment during the academic year and/or employment during the summer). New employees may become eligible for this benefit upon completion of six months of employment.
- 4) Grants are awarded for one academic year and students are required to reapply annually.
- 5) Renewal is based on the availability of funds and is subject to the General Policies of All Programs and the Undergraduate and Graduate Student Financial Aid Statements of Satisfactory Academic Progress in the TCU bulletins.

### HOW TO APPLY

- 1) Applications for undergraduate admission may be obtained by contacting the Admissions Office, TCU Box 297013, Fort Worth, TX 76129, or (817)257-7490. Applications for graduate admission may be obtained by contacting the appropriate College or School.
- 2) A student must be admitted before he/she can be considered for financial assistance of any type.
- 3) Complete and return documents requested by the Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid.
- 4) This form will determine eligibility for the minimum grant from the Tandy fund.\*
