Alumni Half-Tuition Guidelines

Persons with TCU degrees are eligible to take additional *undergraduate courses*, except for performance music, at half-tuition. Funds for this program are limited and some restrictions apply. A student may not be receiving tuition assistance from any other source with the exception of educational loans and may not combine this award with other financial aid administered by TCU. Additionally, a student concurrently enrolled in a graduate degree program at TCU may not combine this award with aid through the Graduate Studies Office. Participants will be eligible for a total of **seven hours** at half tuition per semester (all summer terms combined are considered one semester).

Readmission to the university as a non-degree student is available through the Office of Extended Education. For admission as a degree-seeking student contact the Office of the Registrar.

TCU graduates may apply the Alumni Half-Tuition Grant towards study abroad programs. In this instance, the student may receive the grant and enroll in the class according to their closed class permit.

Registration is on funds and space available on the second day of late registration for the fall and spring semesters and the first day of late registration for the summer terms. **Awards are not retroactive; therefore, anyone who registers during the general registration period will not receive the tuition assistance.**

Applications for Alumni Half-Tuition Assistance are available in the Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid (Sadler Hall, Room 108). Applications will be accepted in advance but will not be processed until late registration is confirmed.

Note: Students receiving assistance through the Alumni Half-Tuition Program must maintain the standards set forth in the “Student Financial Aid Statement of Satisfactory Academic Progress” outlined in the *Undergraduate Studies Bulletin*.
